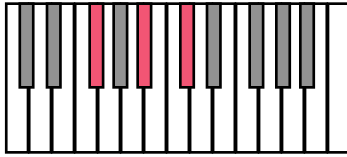


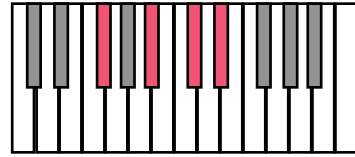
Chords with the Name Gb

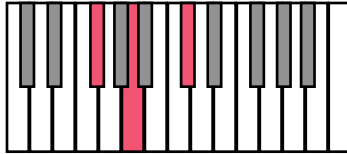
Major chord from which the others are derived.

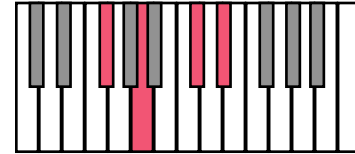
Major 6 - add note 6.

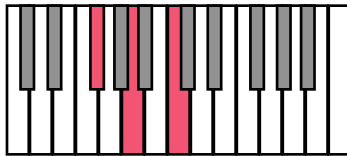
Minor - note 3 is flat.

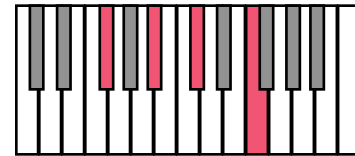
Minor 6 - note 3 flat, add 6.

Gbdim



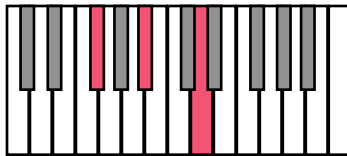
Diminished - notes 3 and 5 are flat.

GbM7



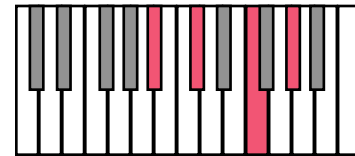
Major 7 - add note 7.

Gbaug



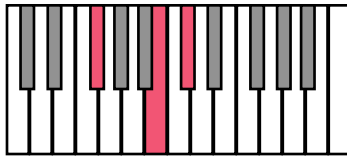
Augmented - note 5 is sharp.

GbM9



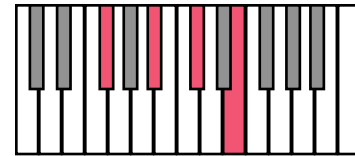
Major 9 - note 1 is omitted. Left hand plays it in the bass.

Gbsus



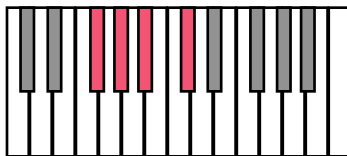
Suspended - note 3 is replaced by note 4.

Gb7



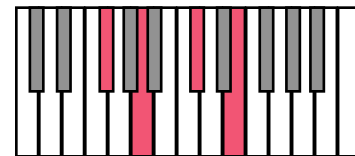
Dominant 7 - called 7 for short. The 7th note of the scale is flat.
