But we're not as close to the stars.

Tiger Lily

Do you like it here?

Wendy

(thoughtfully) I like being a mother to the Lost Boys.
They need one. But I worry about Peter.
Will he never grow up?

Tiger Lily

I don't think he ever will. Does everyone
grow up in your world?

Wendy

They do. One day a child listens to Dad or Mom reading a story. Years go by, and that child reads the same story to his or her own children. Is it not that way here?

Tiger Lily

Time flows in a different way here. Tell me, are you going to go back to your own world?

Wendy

I suppose. I haven't had much time to think about it yet.

Tiger Lily

When you do go back... I'm going to miss you.
